<u>Cadets of Our Lady Affiliated to Legion of Mary</u> –Report by Suzy. KS and Suzy represented the parish at Northampton Cathedral on 5th September. Gave the Bishop the Cadets handbook. Strongly promoting the sacrament of reconciliation.

<u>Allotment</u> – Suzy also explained her background and how she runs several NHS allotments to promote health and wellbeing including the ground behind the hall. Every Sunday there will be produce available on a table behind the Rose Garden, for a donation to help her buy more seeds. Also Holy Water from Lourdes available. Bring your own bottle.

<u>Season of Creation</u> – 1st Sept to 4th Oct - Copy of Pope Francis' letter on the noticeboard. The Pope is asking for our prayers and participation ahead of the COP26 meeting in Glasgow in November. The Pope's message could be added to the portable blue board discussed earlier.

<u>Legion of Mary</u> – KS reported. Celebrated 100 years at the Cathedral on 4th Sept with a special mass. Been active in the parish for 4 years including during lockdown with weekly meetings and home visits. Around 50 families have requested the Enthronement of The Sacred Heart. A few still to be completed will happen soon as we open up after lockdown. KS holds an online Rosary every Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday at 6.30pm.
